Matthew: We had to cooperate with the members of our group.

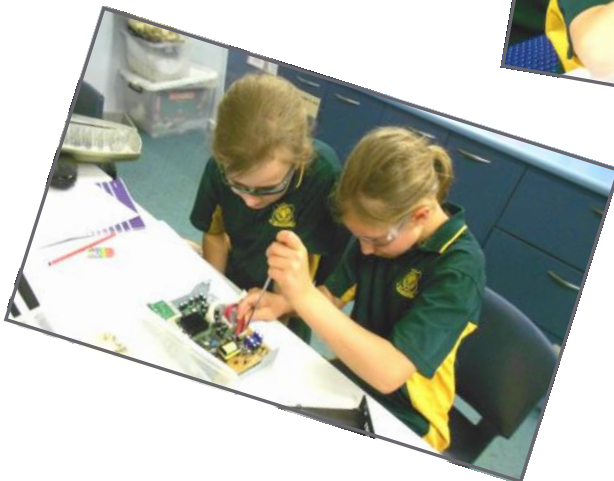
Kaela and Evan: We had to be patient and wait to take turns to use the tools.
