Welcome to Vacation Care for July 2018

Please remember to send named **broad brimmed hats, drink bottles** and a **healthy lunch** each day unless a lunch order is provided. A fridge is available for the storage of lunch boxes and drink bottles. **Lunch orders** will be available one or two days a week, please ensure that correct money is brought on the lunch order day. Money raised will go towards toys and other equipment for the children. Please check each day on the program for what the arrangements for lunch are: lunch orders, lunch supplied or bring your own.

Please do not send nuts or nut products to OSHC as we are strictly a nut free zone.

Please advise us of any allergies or illnesses that we need to be aware of and changes to your contact details.

It is advisable to wear older clothing suitable for messy art activities to ensure good clothes are not damaged or stained.

We have been noticing DS's, IPods', USB's, I Pad's and mobile phones have been brought to OSHC, we ask for these items not to be brought due to risk of damage, lost items or inappropriate data.

It is very important to pre book your children into Vacation Care 24 hours in advance and to notify us, if there are any cancellations or changes. Some days, especially excursion days will be fully booked and we do not want anyone to miss out.

We look forward to your input into the program. If you have any suggestions or ideas please inform a staff member or put your ideas into the parent suggestion book that is in the Children's notice board area.

If you require care for more than 50 hours (4 full days) please organise with Family Assistance office to have your eligible CCB hours increased to 60. You will be charged full fee on the fifth day of the week if this hasn't been organised.

Please note the following regarding Excursions:

- Excursions need to be paid for on the day and permission signed.
- We request that children **do not** bring spending money on excursions. They will not be able to spend it.
- Please refer to our excursion policy for any more details (a copy is in the parent/notice board area)
- Please note the times of departure and arrival from OSHC to save any inconvenience.
