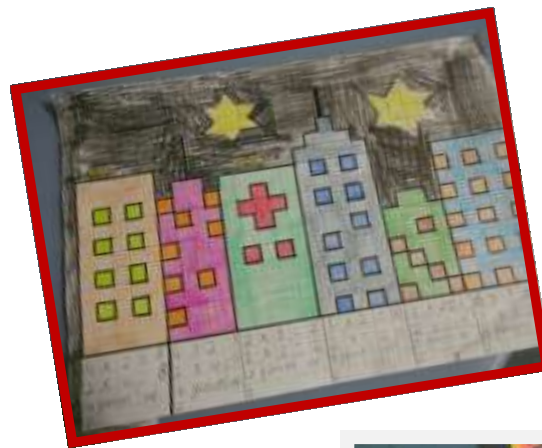

We talked about the Yard Buddies and Mrs S is going to meet with the buddies in week five to see how the program is going

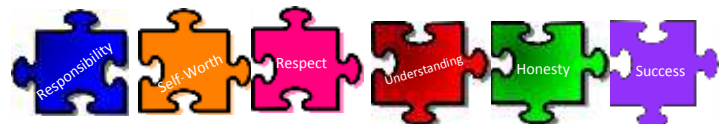
