


Respect - Honesty - Responsibility



Dear Parents and Friends of Renmark West,

Student Free Day

Thank you to our families for supporting our student free day on Tuesday. Our teachers attended a Visible Learning Training Day at the Renmark Hotel. The focus of the day was the SOLO taxonomy. This is about how we can ask questions and set tasks that take students deeper than surface level learning and extend their learning and thinking.

This is the final year of our Visible Learning journey and there will be a second Visible Learning Training day later in the year.

Parent / Teacher Interviews

In week 10 of this term we will be holding parent / teacher interviews. We strongly recommend that parents make a time to come and meet with the classroom teachers to discuss any concerns there may be around a student's learning.

A letter will come home this week and you will be asked to select 5 timeslots that fit in with your work and family commitments.

These need to be returned by the end of next week. In week 9 we will send home a booking confirmation slip.

Interview times are arranged around a teacher's availability during the week. Some teachers may choose to make some early morning times available as well as the after school time slots.

NAPLAN Online Practice

We will be having a practice of the NAPLAN online platform on the 28th March. All Year 3, Year 5 and Year 7 students will be involved. The purpose of the practice is to make sure that our system can manage the upload and download requirements of the test. The actual NAPLAN test is in Term 2 and will involve the Year 3, Year 5 and Year 7 students and will be conducted using the online format.

The Netball District Competition is being held in Term 2 Week I at Berri. The team will be selected over the next few weeks




