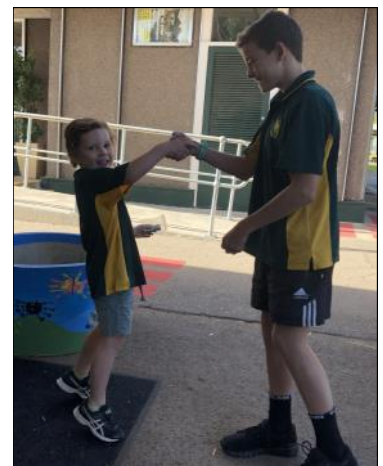

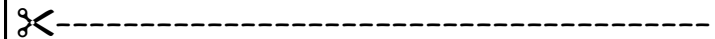
# Spring Fair

The committee meets once a month and closer to the event meetings will possibly be held fortnightly.



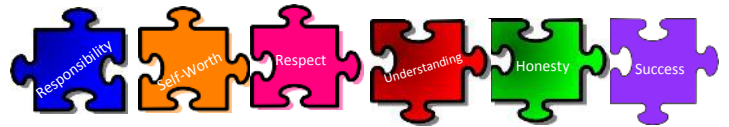
